RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Provide mental health-based services for Achievement Center/ DA Diversion participants and their families
- Provide group and individual counseling to participants
- Provide referrals to resources for participants and families
- Provide crisis intervention
- Create a welcoming and joining climate for all multi-ethnic and linguistic parents
- Collaborate with existing school counseling programs and other agencies that provide counseling to participants and families for care coordination
- Facilitate support groups on topics such as Decision Making, Anger Management, Anti-Theft
- Monitoring quality and timeliness of program documentation, providing input to program management on programmatic issues
- Liaison between staff and parents, Probation, and multidisciplinary teams
- Assist in implementing a yearly needs assessment
- Responsible for data collection, evaluation, measurement of outcomes
- Advocate and inform parents of their rights, school, and state policies
- Coordinate community agency resources on school site
- Assist parents to access and sustain community resources and services
- Maintain positive relationships with school and community agencies
- Attend monthly social work meetings
- Generation of a monthly report.

- 2 years of experience counseling youth with a history of justice-system involvement or other forms of trauma. Experience should preferably have been in a community-based or neighborhood service organization, *preferred*
- Experience in the areas of individual, group, and family counseling, gender-specific services, outreach, community education and development, advocacy and case management.
- Ability to work with a diverse cultural population and diverse age range 6-18.
- Experience with community agencies for participant and parent support
- Knowledge of social work caseload methods and practices
